We are looking for parents to share the story of their child's diagnosis of a medical condition, learning disability, exceptional need, or developmental delay; how they found the resources and support that they needed and what challenges still persist.

Our goal is to create a way for the general public to better understand the impact the diagnosis has had on your family and on your child. This understanding could lead to a more supportive community, ready to create better systems and support networks for other families.

Become part of the Photovoice project, **Ashe Families Finding Hope**. It is a photographic story to tell about the personal challenges and realities of parents and their children with special needs and celebrate their achievements and accomplishments. The photos, taken by a local professional photographer, may be of your child or something that represents your child. The pictures can then be used, with stories composed by the parents, to raise awareness and understanding about the realities of the parents' and children's lives. They will be displayed in community places to spark conversation and understanding. The premier exhibit will be at the Ashe Public Library on May 3rd and the rest of the month and will then move to other community sites in the following months.
